In 25 short years it has become the Miami Valley’s leading urban ministry center. GNH is a role model for Adventist urban ministries nation-wide, offering advanced dental and medical services to the working poor, distributing over 2000 lbs of food each month, and providing educational support to 450 people per month through a variety of classes and counseling services.

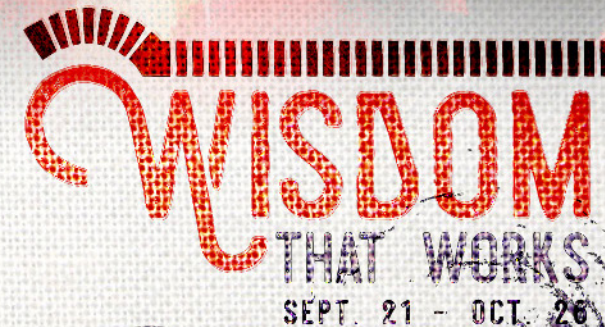
